

# 2014 Residential Recycling Report

### Key

**Tons Landfilled** = Solid waste collected through the community's waste collection program and taken to a landfill for disposal.

# Tons Recycled (Recyclables) =

Recyclables collected through the community's curbside and drop-off recycling programs. Recyclables include paper, cardboard, plastic, cans, glass, scrap metal, appliances, computers, household hazardous wastes and scrap tires.

### **Tons Recycled**

(**Organics**) = Organic waste collected through the community's yard waste collection programs. Organic waste includes leaves, grass and brush.

### Total 2014 Recycling

**Rate** = The percentage of the community's residential waste diverted from landfills through recycling and composting activities in 2014. The recycling rate is calculated by dividing the Tons Recycled by the total tons of waste generated (Tons Landfilled + Tons Recycled).

### **Total 2013 Recycling**

**Rate** = The total percentage of a community's residential waste that was diverted from landfills through recycling and composting activities in 2013 is provided for comparison purposes.

#### Key

#### % **Recycled**

The percentage of a community's total residential waste stream that is collected for recycling through curbside, drop-off and special waste recycling programs. Recyclables include paper, cardboard, plastic, cans, glass, scrap metal, appliances, electronics, and household hazardous wastes and scrap tires.

#### % Composted

The percentage of a community's total residential waste stream that is diverted from landfilling by chipping, mulching and composting programs. Yard waste/ organics include leaves, grass, brush and wood waste.
